

## PROGRAM RATES & REGISTRATION

**WEEKLY RATE:** Tuition is \$140 weekly.

If more than one child from the same family attends during the same week, the tuition is \$125 weekly per child.

**EARLY BIRD RATE:** Register and prepay for three or more sessions by June 8 and pay only \$130.00 per week per child. To take advantage of the early bird rate, payment must be received for a minimum of three weeks **no later than June 8**. Payment for remaining weeks may be forwarded weekly at the early bird rate.

**DAILY RATE:** \$40 per day, per child.

**DEPOSIT:** To secure your child's attendance, a non-refundable \$25 deposit per camper must accompany all completed registration applications.

**LUNCH PROGRAM:** Lunch may be purchased and prepaid in advance for \$20 per week.

**REGISTRATION:** Preregistration is required. Please complete the enrollment application and enclose payment for at least the camper's first intended session. To avoid a late fee of \$35, we **MUST** receive payment by the Friday prior to attending camp. **Early registration is encouraged.**

**PAYMENT:** Please make checks payable to **Mother of Hope Camp** and include your child's full name on all checks.

**REFUND:** Refund (minus \$50 fee) is granted only if the camp office is notified in writing 14 days in advance.

**FINANCIAL AID:** MOH offers a limited amount of tuition assistance for families experiencing financial hardship. Please contact the camp office at **401-568-3580** for financial aid application. **Deadline for submission for financial aid only is June 1, 2010.**

**SUMMER FOOD PROGRAM:** Two weeks tuition is waived if child qualifies for summer food program. Please call the office 401-568-3580 for an application or more information.

**STAFF:** We employ experienced and caring young adults with backgrounds in day care, recreation and youth ministry. Many of our staff are local teachers and educators.

**FACILITIES:** Mother of Hope is a co-educational day camp for children from ages 5-12. The camp boasts a private beach and bath house, athletic field, basketball court, numerous hiking trails, picnic area, arts and crafts center, assembly pavilions, playground, challenge course, infirmary, and a beautiful camp chapel. **We are well equipped to make any camper's summer a great one!**



**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation is included in the price of tuition. MOH provides bus service to neighborhoods throughout northern, central, and western Rhode Island. Parents find this very convenient, since connections to camp are typically just a few blocks from home.

**WHAT TO BRING:** Campers participate in a variety of activities. They should arrive at camp wearing sneakers or a sturdy pair of boots. **NO** sandals or open toe shoes are allowed. Flip flops may be packed and worn at the waterfront only. Pack a small backpack or over-the-shoulder bag with:

- water bottle
- insect repellent
- lunch
- rain gear (rainy days)
- sunscreen
- bathing suit (one piece recommended)
- towel
- sweatshirt

**WHAT NOT TO BRING:** Please no backpacks with wheels. Flip flops and sandals may be worn at the waterfront only. Be sure to label all possessions. Do NOT bring radios, cassettes, toys, sports equipment, portable electronic games, MP3 players, iPods, cell phones, etc. **Mother of Hope is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damage to personal belongings.**

Mother of Hope Camp is approximately two miles beyond that point, on the right, on Route 44. The address is 1589 Putnam Pike (AKA Route 44), Chepachet, RI 02814.

**BUS SAFETY RULES:** For the safety of the campers, all children are to remain seated during the bus ride. Hands must be inside the bus at all times. No throwing objects outside the bus. No eating or drinking on the bus. If a child does not adhere to bus safety rules then the parent is responsible for providing alternate transportation to camp.
