Anne Marie has served in parish youth ministry, facilitates retreats, gives keynote addresses, sings, and is a master storyteller. She has appeared on national stages including the National Catholic Youth Conference (NCYC), as well as NCCYM, sharing the Gospel message with humor, heart and high heels.

This Catholic Middle School Youth Conference (**CMSYC**) is offered in conjunction with the Commotion event offered to all Catholic youth of our diocese in grades 6, 7 and 8 on Saturday, December 4th. Youth who attend CMSYC may still attend the Saturday “Commotion” event with their parish or school.



Registration is limited to 400 participants and thus will be taken on a first come, first served basis. Please note that Schools are **responsible financially for the total number of students that they register.** Suggested ratio of students to adults is 1 adult for every 10 students. For safety purposes a complete list of student participants must be presented to the CMSYC leadership no later than the day of the conference. The cost of the conference is **\$10** per student and includes a pizza and juice lunch. Teachers and chaperones attend at no cost. Additional students may be added until the maximum registration number has been reached. Snacks will be available for purchase.
